... SOME PRACTICAL TIPS TO FACILITATE YOUR STAY ...

The day before your arrival phone (at meal times or in the evening) to **DANIELLE: 05.62.92.91.92** to set the conditions of the meeting that could take place in front of the town hall of BETPOUEY, or if you want directly in front of the house if your GPS (42.879143, 0.032977) takes you there.

Built in the mountains, the house is modern and functional and our guests enjoy it without any worries. Naturally, carefully locate the places with the children and keep them under surveillance because there are important differences in level, even gullies. Please, ask them not to walk in the uncut hay fields.

<u>In summer, all models of cars can access to the house. In winter, no vehicle can access if there are snow</u> drifts. Danielle will tell you if the path is clear and practicable. To avoid any eventuality, it is wise to make several light luggage if you have to go on foot. A part of them can thus stay in the car and be worn later. Do not leave the car parked near the house unless you are absolutely certain that it will not snow and check the mountain weather before climbing. In the slightest doubt, get off and park the car in the village. On the turnover area, do not park directly under the rock face. At night, a "back and forth" will allow you to illuminate the pedestrian path from the house to your car.

Mobile phones have a very good reception from home.

The dustbins are to go down to the village by operating a selective sorting. Do not throw any object or tampon into the toilet and do not use **bleach** as there is a septic tank.

Circuit breakers are in the electrical panel in the kitchen. The hot water tank of 150 liters heats at night (unless otherwise required). If necessary, switch on heating from 22 hours to 7 hours. The home has a Controlled Mechanical Ventilation that must be turned off (button close to worktop in the kitchen) when you heat. Lights are designed to light up together simultaneously. Do not plug the vacuum cleaner to the sockets with lamps and dimmers (marked in red). Use the extractor hood when cooking to keep the house clean and inviting. At high altitude, the cooking times are longer and the use of the pressure cooker will reduce them.

Fresh and excellent water comes from a spring. However, we do not guarantee its drinkability by regular analysis and we advise you to boil it the day before, for the next day, to drink it. The pressure may drop briefly from time to time (if one of the five users of the spring is wasting abnormally). **In very cold winter, let a stream of water flow from a tap.** In summer, thank you to put some water to the flowers if they are thirsty.

We ask you not to smoke and to access barefoot (oak parquet flooring) in the bedrooms .

The permanently lit insect lamp will effectively protect you from flies (sporadic crackle) and help keep the house clean in summer. Insecticide tapes and insect bug are also available.

Watch out for the gale! particularly in the event of a thunderstorm. The wind can overturn and lift all the garden furniture. After use, store it carefully along a sheltered wall and during your absences, do not leave windows open.

Parasol umbrella and deckchairs are behind the sofa. In the trunk: - two hammocks (anchor hooks on the three stone terraces) - two pairs of snowshoes to use around the house - the vacuum cleaner). The device records are in the "welcome" folder.

Report any difficulty and anomaly - you will not have to pay the small thing broken in the everyday life - so that next holidaymakers have also a great time.
